Facts: Silicon Valley's Airport



Location

Located on 1,050 acres in the heart of Silicon Valley, Mineta San José International Airport (SJC) is owned and operated by the City of San José. The Airport is bordered on the south by I-880, on the east by Highway 87, and to the north by Highway 101, offering easy access for passengers throughout Silicon Valley and the San Francisco Bay Area.

Passenger Traffic

- 13.5 million passengers in FY 17-18
- Approximately 37,000 passengers daily
- Continues to be one of the fastest-growing major airports in the U.S.

Terminals

Terminal A: 17 gates (including enhanced international facilities)
Terminal B: 14 gates; new interim 4-gate facility opens in 2019

Budget

- \$180 million operating budget in FY 18-19
- A self-supporting enterprise with revenues coming from landing fees, rents, concession fees, and other user fees
- No local taxes are used for the operation or development of the Airport.
- Federal grants contribute to some capital improvements.
- The Airport has a direct staffing level of 215 employees and more than 5,000 badged employees on the airport.

Economic Impact

- 1,020,400 jobs in the San José/Silicon Valley area
- 105 companies within 18 miles of SJC worth \$39.3 billion in capital expenditures, with \$628 billion in global sales
